JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 5 to reconstruct/complete the service book of the petitioner and further to direct respondents No.1 to 6 to release the pensionary/retiral benefits of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.2012 after taking into consideration the selection grade w.e.f. 01.01.2002 granted vide order dated 04.08.2006 (Annexure P-6) and also by affixation of the pay of the petitioner in the revised pay scale w.e.f. 01.01.2006 as has been allowed to the other employees; to release the salary of the period of suspension from 23.01.2004 to 04.04.2005 which has been treated to be on duty period for all intents and purposes vide order dated 04.01.2010 (Annexure P-3) etc. along with the interest from the date of accrual of the legal dues.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-15) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the official respondent(s) to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-15) with further direction to complete the service book within a period of one month and then to take a conscious decision with regard to disbursement of the pensionary benefits within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The factum of grant of interest on the delayed payments be also considered by the competent authority.
