The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India (by way of PIL) for issuance of a writ of *mandamus*, directing the respondent(s) to set up the Nodal Authority as envisaged under Section 8 of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation), Act, 2006 (in short 'the Act'), for ensuring that private health sciences educational institutions in the State of Punjab conduct admissions in a fair and transparent manner and for fixation of fee etc.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent(s)/State has produced the Notification bearing No.5/22/2016-5HB-III/2018 dated 24.05.2017, whereby the Nodal Authority was constituted consisting of Vice Chancellor, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and Director, Research

and Medical Education, Punjab. A copy of the notification has been given to the petitioner. In view thereof, learned counsel for the respondent(s) submitted that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

3. The petitioner does not dispute the said fact.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
