By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release pensionary benefits i.e. gratuity, leave encashment, GIS, arrear of pension and GPF etc. along with interest on the delayed payment of pensionary benefits i.e. GPF, GIS, Earned Leave, DCRG, Pension etc. in terms of statutory rules, Govt. instructions and law laid down by full bench of this Court in “R.S. Randhawa v. State of Punjab, 1997 (3) RSJ 318.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) was moved to the respondent(s) but till date, no action has been taken.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to decide the same particularly, in view of the observations made by Full Bench of this Court in case captioned as “***R.S. Randhawa vs. State of Punjab, 1997 (3) RSJ 318***”, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
