In the instant petition, petitioner has assailed the notice dated 23.5.2017. Under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, writ Court can entertain petition in respect of notice only on the ground of competency and violation of any statutory provisions. Petitioner has not urged any ground relating to competency and violation of statutory provisions in respect of Annexure P-8, notice dated 23.5.2017.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to file necessary explanation to the notice dated 23.5.2017. If such explanation is furnished by the petitioner, respondents are at liberty to pass a speaking order and communicate the same to the petitioner.
