This petition is filed to challenge the order dated 18.1.2012 passed by
the Zonal Dispute Settlement Committee.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that as per the
Electricity Supply Instructions Manual, the petitioner has the remedy to appeal
before the forum for redressal of its grievances and thereafter before the ombudsman
electricity.

Faced with this objection, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed
for withdrawal of the petition in order to avail its remedy in accordance with the
aforesaid regulation.

Consequently, the present petition is hereby allowed to be withdrawn
with liberty to the petitioner to take up its remedy in accordance with law. In case
the appeal is filed before the Forum by the petitioner within 15 days from the receipt
of certified copy of this order, neither the Forum nor the respondent shall raise any
objection to the limitation.
