By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the military service rendered by the petitioner during Second National Emergency from 03.12.1971 to 25.03.1977 towards his pensionary benefits as per order dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-4) passed in CWP No. 17661 of 2013 titled as Rajinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others with further direction to release all the consequential benefits alongwith interest.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the representation dated April 12, 2017 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated April 12, 2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same in accordance with law, particularly in view of a Division Bench judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 17661 of 2013, decided on November 13, 2014 titled as **Rajinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others;** within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
