Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with their junior w.e.f. due date and further to grant all arrears of pay and consequential benefits along with interest @ 12% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits he feels satisfied in case direction is given to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 03.08.2015 (Annexure P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated

03.08.2015 (Annexure P-7) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
