Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a similar controversy came before this Court in a bunch of petitions which was disposed of on 23.05.2017, the lead case being CWP no.11038 of 2017, titled as Harish Kumar v. State of Haryana and others.

In those cases, a statement had been made by the learned State counsel appearing, to the effect that any placement (transfer) made by the State, would be provisional and the claim of all those petitioners would ultimately be considered, after or at the time of adjustment and posting of the newly appointed teachers.

Those writ petitions were, therefore, disposed of in terms of the aforesaid statement, after which CWP no.14518 of 2017 has been disposed of by this Court on the same parameters, on 10.07.2017.

Learned counsel submits that this petition may also be disposed of in the same terms as CWP no.11038 of 2017 and other connected matters decided along with it on 23.05.2017, as per the statement of the learned

State counsel in that case.

Disposed of in the above terms.

Since this petition is being disposed of without issuing notice, if the State finds that the present matter is not covered by the aforesaid judgment, or there is any other issue involved, it would be at liberty to file an appropriate application.
