Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent to release the retiral benefits i.e. gratuity, leave encashment etc. and any other retiral benefit to the petitioner along with interest @ 12% per annum w.e.f. 30.04.2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits he feels satisfied in case direction is given to the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 09.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated

09.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
