By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the retiral benefits and other arrears alongwith interest @18% p.a. to the petitioner.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner has moved various representations including representation dated July 04, 2017 but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation dated July 04, 2017, within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in

his representation dated July 04, 2017 and to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed then the same will be released/dispensed to him within a period of next two months.
