In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 and 5 on the score that respondents No.4 and 5 have demanded illegal gratification from the petitioner to pass order in favour of the petitioner. Having regard to the nature of relief sought in the present petition, petitioner has to approach higher authorities and if they found that allegations made by the petitioner are prima facie true in that event they will initiate necessary disciplinary proceedings or any other proceedings. Therefore, this court cannot give directions to the official respondents to take action against respondents No.4 and 5 as prayed in the present petition.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
