DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that she is physically disabled to the extent of 50% permanent disability on account of post polio paralysis of right lower limb. Her work is satisfactory and no complaint or shortcoming is there. She has to travel about 130 kilometers daily and it is very difficult for her to travel such a long distance on account of disability.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide guidelines/instructions dated 11.4.2017, applications were invited from the officers/officials for their transfers considering their difficulties. The petitioner also submitted application for her transfer but no action has been taken thereupon. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has also made representations on 24.4.2017 and 7.5.2017, which are annenxed

as Annexures P-4 and P-5 with the writ petition. Learned counsel also contends that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to the respondents to consider her representations in view of guidelines/instructions dated 11.4.2017.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and by considering the limited prayer, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the representations of the petitioner dated 24.4.2017 and 7.5.2017 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) and take necessary action in accordance with law as well as in view of guidelines/instructions dated 11.4.2017 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. It is also directed that while considering the case of the petitioner her disability and distance between two places be also considered sympathetically.
