By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the pay and pension of the petitioners by granting them promotional increment on higher responsibility in terms of notification dated 11.04.2005, vide which, the pay scale of the Chief Sanitary Inspector has been revised from 5800-9200 to 6400-10640 with all consequential benefits along with interest in terms of law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in *R.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab, 1997(3) RSJ 318*.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in

their legal notice dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same in accordance with law particularly in view the judgment passed in case of *R.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab, 1997(3) RSJ 318*, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
