JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order of the respondents, vide which the monthly financial assistance granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 31.05.2011 under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 was stopped without passing any formal order and without conducting regular enquiry and without granting any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, being illegal and against the principle of natural justice.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondent(s) to decide representation dated 25.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in

her representation dated 25.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
