Through the instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari by quashing the letter dated 06.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) and 27.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) vide which the genuine claim of the petitioner has been rejected by the respondents as well as writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of petitioner sympathetically and to grant him the benefit of pension from the Army side as the same is more beneficial and the same being duly endorsed by respondent No.6 vide its email dated 28th January, 2017 (Annexure P-3) and the anomaly as highlighted by them in this email.

The petitioner is advised to approach the concerned authorities by moving a detailed representation narrating all the facts and circumstances as well as the relief claimed and if the petitioner still feels dissatisfied from the action taken by the concerned authorities, is at liberty to approach this Court.
