In pursuance of the order dated 18.07.2017 passed by this Court, learned counsel appearing for U.T. Chandigarh has produced '*Sajra*' in the Court, whereby it has been proposed that a passage which is 14' wide and 52" in length close to the Govt. tubewell linking the un-acquired portion of land with a pucca road, shall be provided by Union Territory, Chandigarh. The needful shall be done within a period of six weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that there are number of co-sharers in the portion of un-acquired land. The passage may be linking one portion thereof.

For that purpose, the co-sharers may avail appropriate remedy available for providing passage to all of them.

In view of the aforesaid factual matrix as the passage to the un-acquired portion of land has now been provided by the Union Territory, Chandigarh, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
