Counsel submits that the petitioners herein had applied for the post of Constable (Driver) in the District Police Cadre in Punjab Police in pursuance to advertisement dated 15.10.2016. Further contended that the petitioners had successfully negotiated the selection process and were issued appointment letters on 26.12.2016. In support of such contention documents placed on record at Annexures P-2 to P-4 have been adverted to.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that inspite of issuance of appointment letters and conduct of medical examination and police verification thereafter, the petitioners are not being permitted to join on the post.

Counsel has very candidly apprised the Court that certain other candidates have raised a challenge to the selection process before this Court in which the petitioners had participated but as of date there is no interim order passed by the Court which would be seen as an impediment for the petitioners to join on the post in question.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without even going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority/respondent no.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioners in the light of three separate legal notices carrying even date i.e. 25.5.2017 (Annexures P-9 to P-11) and to thereafter take action as deemed fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
