By this petition, the petitioner's appointment on regular basis as a Dental Assistant is sought, he having worked as such in the Haryana Armed Police Hospital at Madhuban from 04.01.2008 to 16.09.2016, though his present posting on regular basis is that of a Water Carrier.

In support of his specific contention, that the post is lying vacant, the contention is that the petitioner having worked for eight long years on the said post, it cannot be said that there is no work existing.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner had got a legal notice issued on his behalf on 16.03.2017 (Annexure P-7), addressed to respondents No.2 to 5 herein, with respondent No.5, i.e. the Director General, Health Service, Haryana, having replied to the said notice vide his communication (Annexure P-8), stating therein that the post in question has nothing to do with the Health Department and falls within the purview of the Police Department.

Consequently, without commenting on the merits of the

petition at this stage, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, i.e. the Inspector General of Police, Haryana Armed Police, Madhuban, to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice dated 16.03.2017, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
