By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the approval of 3rd ACP as per Rule-7(4) w.e.f. 01.05.2008 in pay scale of ₹9300-34800+3300 G.P. And pay be re-fixed accordingly with all consequential benefits and thereafter re-fixation of pension and arrear of retiring benefits of 24% per annum from the due date to till date of realization of payment. Further to decide the legal notice dated 20.03.2017 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though legal notice dated 20.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) was duly served upon the respondent(s) but till date, no action has been taken.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 20.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) and to decide the same particularly, in view of order dated 22.02.2017 and letter dated 26.04.2017 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
