By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner which includes gratuity, leave encashment and other consequential benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was retired as Manager on 31.07.2015 but his retiral benefits including gratuity, leave encashment and other consequential benefits have not been released so far. Thereafter, the petitioner has got served a legal notice dated 31.05.2017

(Annexure P-1) but till date no action has been taken by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 31.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 31.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
