Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to supply necessary information pertaining to ancestral land left by Pritam Singh father of the petitioner in Pakistan during partition.

However, no response has been received till now. He further submits that another letter shall be addressed to the concerned authority by the Ministry at the earliest in any case not later than two months.
