In the present writ petition, petitioners have questioned the validity of the awards dated 22.04.2016 (Annexures P15/1 to P15/5) of the Labour Court-cum-Industrial Tribunal, Patiala and resolution dated 14.12.2007 (Annexure P12).

The Award is relating to respondent-employer and private respondents-employees. Therefore, petitioner has no locus standi to challenge the awards passed on 22.04.2016 in favour of the private respondents. Insofar as challenge to the resolution dated 14.12.2007 to the extent that official respondents have made their statement before the Labour Court is contrary to the resolution to the extent of surplus of employees. Even challenge to the resolution dated 14.12.2007 (Annexure P12) is concerned, there is delay and further if official respondents have made any contrary statement before the Labour court in respect of resolution dated 14.12.2007 even then petitioner has no locus standi. Petitioners failed to appreciate in what way their rights are affected due to passing of awards read with resolution dated 14.12.2007.

Accordingly, on the ground of locus standi, CWP stands dismissed.
