By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to pay the unpaid retiral benefit such as gratuity, leave encashment and other retiral benefits and arrears along with 12% interest on account of delay in payment of retiral benefits from the date of superannuation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 01.06.2017 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated

01.06.2017 (Annexure P-6) and to decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
