By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to refix the pension of petitioners pre 01.01.2006 as per Punjab Government Circulars dated 17.08.2009 (Annexure P-1), dated 22.02.2010 (Annexure P-2) and dated 15.12.2011 (Annexure P-3) and judgment dated 22.10.2013 passed in CWP No. 25733 of 2012, titled as A.P. Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though the petitioners have served the respondents with legal notices dated 06.05.2017 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) but till date no action, has been taken. The petitioners

feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to consider their claim set out in the legal notices.

Thus, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notices dated May 06, 2017 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
