By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially, a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated August 27, 2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2 with further direction to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pensionary benefits alongwith interest @ 18% PA.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a representation dated June 28, 2016 (Annexure P-6) was moved by the petitioner to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken. Moreover, the amount

on account of which the pensionary benefits of the petitioner were withheld by the respondents has since been recovered by the respondent No.4.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated June 28, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
