In the instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release due benefits including pensionary benefits along with interest, especially in view of **CWP No. 26520 of 2014, Kulbir Singh Vs. The Pepsu Road Transport Corporation and another decided on 23.07.2016 as well as D.D. Tewari (D) through Lrs Vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. & others**, decided by Hon'ble Supreme Court on 01.08.2014, wherein directions have been issued to grant interest @ 9% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that an identical question of law, which is involved in the instant petition, has already been decided by this Court vide order dated September 04, 2017 passed in CWP No. 15306 of 2016 titled as, “**Hari Ram & others Vs.**

Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Nabha Road, Patiala”. He further

submitted that instant petition be disposed of in terms of order date September 04, 2017 passed in CWP No. 15306 of 2016 for the grant of retiral benefits and interest on delayed payment(s).

3. The above said fact has not been disputed by learned counsel for the respondent.
