This application has been moved for placing on record legal notice dated 12.05.2017 as Annexure P-9.

C.M is allowed and Annexure P-9 is taken on record.

CWP No.16719 of 2017

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that the petitioner is entitled to be considered for promotion in view of letter dated 23.09.2011. He further submits that in this regard, not only the representation has been made but a legal notice dated 12.05.2017 (Annexure P-9) has also been served upon the respondents but in spite of that, no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 12.05.2017.

Keeping in view the limited prayer and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider legal notice dated 12.05.2017

(Annexure P-9) and pass necessary orders in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

However, in case, the petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the legal notice, the same be granted to him within a period of three months thereafter and in case, he is not found to be entitled, then a detailed speaking order be passed in accordance with law.
