The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 21/25.07.2017 [Annexure P-10(colly.)] passed by the Additional Excise and Taxation Commissioner-cum-Collector (Excise), UT, Chandigarh.

2. It has been averred by learned counsel that vide the impugned order [Annexure P-10(colly.)], the license of the petitioner has been ordered to be suspended for 4 days w.e.f. 31.07.2017 to 03.08.2017. The said order has also been impugned on the ground that it is an illegal order passed by respondent No.3.

3. It was not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that against the impugned order [Annexure P-10(colly.)], separate appeals have been filed before respondent No.2, which are pending.

4. Mr. Vikas Bali, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the respondents-U.T., Chandigarh and stated that the appellate authority is holding the office and shall decide the appeals today itself.

5. Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.2 to decide the appeals today itself in accordance with law for which the petitioner shall appear before the said authority at 3 pm.
