Through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner seeks issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the decision regarding grant of LPG distributorship to respondent No. 4 in the draw held on 26.04.2016 at Jalandhar and for a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to hold the draw afresh. The petitioner has, with an intention to express his grievance/complaint, sent a legal notice to the authorities of the Indian Oil Corporation. Being an aggrieved person, the petitioner has got a remedy to file complaint expressing his grievance as per para 3 of the Brochure of Guidelines for Selection of Regular LPG Distributors.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been informed that the complaint, if made by the petitioner, would be dealt with, in

accordance with Clause 13 of the Brochure.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.

Notice has been accepted by Mr. Ashish Kapoor, Advocate,

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the
grievance of the petitioner will be finally adjudicated upon by
respondent No. 3 within a period of three months after the receipt of
certified copy of the order.
