By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the counting of his past service in Haryana State Minor Irrigation Tubewell Corporation as qualifying service for the pension.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has moved an application/representation dated March 12, 2017 (Annexure P3) to respondents no. 3 and 4 but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents no. 3 and 4 to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 3

and 4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated March 12, 2017 (Annexure P-3) and to decide the same, particularly in view of instruction dated December 16, 2010 issued by Government of Haryana as well Judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 26716 of 2014 titled as *Nathu Singh vs. State of Haryana & others* decided on September 27, 2016, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
