AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

On 01.02.2017 the following order was passed :-

“The petitioner has competed for selection and appointment against 12 posts of Post Graduate Teachers in History reserved for the Physical Handicap Category. His grievance is that as per the answer keys uploaded by the Haryana Staff Selection Board, the petitioner would secure 109 marks, however, his name does not find mention in the final selection list for the Physical Handicap Category declared on 16.1.2017, while person with 89 marks has been selected.

Notice of motion for 06.2.2017.

On the asking of the Court, Sh. Rohit Arya, AAG, Haryana accepts notice and prays for some time to seek instructions. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to furnish requisite number of copies of paper book to him during the course of the day.”

Today learned Additional Advocate General has shown to me the original OMR sheet of the petitioner. I find that in two questions i.e. 46 and 51 first another option was marked and later on that was erased and second option was marked. As per the instructions any attempt to erase or over-right would render the person ineligible and the answer sheet of such a person would be cancelled because that answer sheet would not be accepted by the computer.

In these circumstances, I find no ground to interfere. Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
