This Court, while issuing notice of motion, passed the following order:-

“ Petitioner was working as Senior Assistant with the Punjab State Agriculture Marketing Board and was prematurely retired vide order dated 11.9.2014(P-1) in public interest. The statutory revision dated 10.10.2014 was filed before the Government-respondent no.1 which is still pending.

Although the prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the order dated 11.9.2014(P-1), however, at the time of hearing learned counsel restricts his claim to the alternative prayer of issuing a mandamus to the revisional authority to decide his revision pending since last two years.

Notice of motion to respondent no.1 only at this stage.

Counsel for the petitioner to supply requisite copies of paper book to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Vaibhav Sharma, DAG Punjab accepts notice and prays for time to seek instructions.

List on 17.10.2016. ”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the revision petition has since been decided by passing a speaking order dated 29.12.2016, copy of which has been placed on record.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
