JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the 3rd ACP as per notification dated 04.03.2014. However, junior to the petitioner i.e. Jagbir Singh Conductor No.C-119, who join in the department dated 10.01.1983, whereas the date of joining to the petitioner 08.01.1983 through SSS Board. The petitioner is also entitle 3rd ACP from the date of that junior have been granted w.e.f. 01.04.2014. He is also entitle the increment, due between 01.01.2006 to 01.07.2006 as per notification dated 16.04.2012 with all consequential benefits along with 18% per annum from the date of accrual till the date of realization.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to the Appellate Authority i.e. General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sonapat to decide departmental appeal preferred by the petitioner within a time bound period which is pending disposal since October, 2015. The petitioner stood retired on attaining the age of

superannuation on 31st December, 2015 and a period of more than 1 ½ years has expired after his retirement but his appeal has not been finally disposed of which is causing a great financial loss to him.

In view of the facts and circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3-General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sonapat to consider and decide the appeal pending before him within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

If the petitioner still aggrieved of the order passed by the Appellate Authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court again for the redressal of his grievances.
