Learned counsel for the petitioner has challenged the validity of the award passed by the Labour court dated 20.03.2015 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that respondent is working with Director, Women and Child Development which is not an industry. Therefore, award passed by the Labour court is without jurisdiction. It is to be noted that as and when respondent-workman raised an industrial dispute, the same has been referred by the Government for adjudication. In the present matter industrial dispute has been referred for adjudication on 16.02.2009 by the Chandigarh Administration. The said reference dated 16.02.2009 has not been questioned by the petitioners. In the absence of questioning reference, petitioners' contention that integrated Child Development Services is not an

industry issue cannot considered. Therefore, petitioners have not made out a case so as to interfere with the award passed by the Labour Court dated 20.03.2015.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
