By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to make the payment of remaining retiral benefits of petitioner along with interest from the date of retirement till date with immediate effect. Further, to decide the legal notice dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to

respondent No.2, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by respondent No.2, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
