The petitioner applied for admission to MBBS Course in the State of Punjab in the reserved category of Scheduled Caste. While submitting his online application, he has appended a Scheduled Caste certificate dated 11.07.2013 issued by the Chandigarh Administration as the petitioner/his family are permanent residents of U.T. Chandigarh. His mother, however, is serving in the Education Department, Punjab Government. A certificate issued to his mother by the Principal of Government Senior Secondary School, Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib dated 03.07.2017 (P-6) certifying that as per the office record petitioner's mother belongs to Scheduled Caste category, was also uploaded while submitting online application. The petitioner has been eventually treated as a General Category candidate by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences. The aggrieved petitioner made a representation to the Registrar of respondent-University but finding no response, has filed the instant writ petition.

The question whether the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of

prescribed in the Prospectus or the Government Instructions, can be effectively determined by the University authorities. The writ petition is thus disposed of with a direction to the Registrar of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot to consider the above mentioned claim of the petitioner and decide the same within a period of three days from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Let a copy of this order be given dasti to learned counsel for the petitioner today itself under the signatures of the Bench Secretary.
