The petitioner's grievance is that Gram Panchayat land has been illegally encroached by private respondents and no action is being taken by the Gram Panchayat or other official respondents despite the fact that legal notice dated 23.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) was also served for seeking timely action.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought in this petition but without expressing any views on merits, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to take cognizance of the legal notice sent on behalf of the petitioner and hold a fact finding enquiry, if need be, and if it is found that the Gram Panchayat land/Shamlat Deh land has been illegally encroached upon, let necessary follow up action be taken within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
