JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 13.06.2016 (Annexure P-4) to the extent that petitioner is not entitled for full amount and whereby a meagre amount of ₹13,31,161/- has been sanctioned and further directing the respondents to consider the medical claims and reimburse the amount of ₹27,14,077/- along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Concededly, the case of the petitioner is fully covered with the judgment rendered by this Court in **CWP No. 5714 of 2014**, captioned as “***Hari Chand v. State of Punjab and others***”, decided on 06.01.2016 (Annexure P-5).

It being so, the petitioner is also entitled to the same relief, which has been granted to the petitioner in ***Hari Chand's*** case (supra).

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to calculate and disburse the pecuniary benefits accrued to the petitioner in terms of *Hari Chand's* case (supra) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
4. However, in case of non-compliance of order of this Court, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
