By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant consequential benefit of promotion to the post of Head Master w.e.f. 04.10.2011 i.e. the date on which persons junior to the petitioner were promoted as such on account of extension in the date of retirement of the petitioner and to give consequential benefits of refixation of pay as Head Master and pension etc. for which he is legally entitled.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 20.07.2016 (Annexure P-9) was moved to the respondent(s), but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondent(s) to decide the representation within a

stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent(s), to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 20.07.2016 (Annexure P-9) and take a conscious decision, particularly in view of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 2914 of 2012 (O&M), titled as *“April Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another”*, which has been upheld by the Hon'ble Apex Court, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
