Petitioner has challenged the validity of the award dated 16.1.2015. The petitioner is stated to have been appointed as a Ground Man on 10.12.2001. His services have been relieved on 31.7.2012 with reference to the fact that petitioner has completed 60 years of age. Petitioner claims that his date of birth is 11.4.1962, therefore, he is entitled to continue in service beyond 31.7.2012. Hence, relieving him on 31.7.2012 is contrary to the date of birth of the petitioner. petitioner has failed to produce any document to show that his date of birth is 11.4.1962. On the other hand, there is a material of Voter Card which discloses that petitioner is aged about 42 years as on 1.1.1994. In view of these facts and circumstances, no interference is called for in respect of award passed by the Labour Court dated 16.1.2015.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
