The petitioners are residents of Village Salem Shah, Tehsil & District, Fazilka. A part of the land which vests in the Gram Panchayat of their village has been leased out for 33 years to respondent No.10-District Animal Welfare Society (Regd.), Fazilka, for setting up a Goushala for taking care of the domestic animals. The petitioners claim that the land could not have been leased out and expressing their grievance against the same, they served the Authorities with legal notice dated 2.3.2017 (Annexure P-8). As no action was taken on the legal notice, the instant writ petition has been filed.

After going through the averments made in the writ petition but without expressing any views on merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to consider the legal notice (Annexure P-8) sent on behalf of the petitioners and decide the same

by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
