Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the death of husband of the petitioner, the representations were made on 24.01.2016 and 26.07.2016 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively). Thereafter, a legal notice was also served upon the respondents on 08.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) but no action has been taken thereupon so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide her legal notice dated 08.03.2017 (Annexure P-4).

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the legal notice dated 08.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary action in accordance with law and policy framed in this regard within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
