The petitioner, who was serving as a Head Constable, filed the instant petition impugning two orders of transfer dated 7.7.2017 and 27.6.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby he was transferred from Ferozepur to S.B.S. Nagar and then to Faridkot.

When the writ petition came up for preliminary hearing on 8.8.2017, counsel for the petitioner had made a categorical submission that the petitioner is not assailing his transfer but is limiting his grievance only as regards being permitted to join at any place of posting.

Against such limited grievance notice of motion had been issued.

During the course of hearing today, learned State counsel states that the petitioner has been permitted to join at S.B.S. Nagar.

In the light of such categorical stand taken on behalf of the State nothing would survive in the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
