The petitioners have filed the present petition claiming that in view of the provisions of Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, the acquisition has lapsed, as the petitioners have neither been paid compensation for the acquired land nor possession of the land has been taken from them. Notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 were issued on 29.11.2001 and 28.11.2002, respectively.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that he has received copy of the communication dated 8.8.2016 from the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana stating that the acquisition in question has been dropped by the State.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous. The same is disposed of as such.
