By this writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order (Annexure P-5) by which the earlier vice versa transfer of the petitioner vis.a.vis respondent No.3 was cancelled.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the original transfer was made as a part of general transfer and the petitioner joined at Hisar but within 20 days, the order was cancelled due to political machinations of respondent No.3.

On the other hand, the stand taken is that the transfer is purely an administrative matter and there are no machinations of respondent No.3.

In the circumstances of the case, I am not persuaded to interfere

with the impugned order. Consequently, this writ petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
