The petitioners have constructed their houses unauthorizedly on the land which vests in the Gram Panchayat. The Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Karnal passed the order dated 27.09.2007 (P-1) in the eviction proceedings initiated under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, as applicable to the State of Haryana, that the petitioners shall deposit the market value of the land as per the Government Policy. The petitioners' claim that they have been running from pillar to post to deposit the market value of the land but no follow-up action has been taken by the respondents.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any views on merits or on their entitlement, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 5 to verify the above-mentioned claim of the petitioners and decide the same by way of a reasoned order within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

The residential houses of the petitioners be not demolished till
the reasoned order is passed.
