The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to offer appointment letter to the petitioners, who are stated to be in the waiting list.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a legal notice was served upon the respondents, which was responded stating that the posts are lying vacant but the same is pending for taking decision.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioners and have also perused the documents available on the file.

Petitioners are in the waiting list at serial Nos.11, 18 and 142 as mentioned in letter dated 09.05.2017 (Annexure P-7). Said letter has been communicated by the respondents to the petitioners by informing that the Chairman, Recruitment Board has revised the result and the same has been sent for approval but no action has been taken so far for offering appointment to the candidates who are in the waiting list.

The matter is still pending for approval and it cannot be said as to how many vacancies are there as on today and how many candidates, who have been selected, have not joined. The cause of action arises to the petitioners when clear cut vacancies are there and other selected candidates have not joined. Nothing has been mentioned in the petition as well as during arguments as to how many vacancies are there and the persons, who are senior in the merit list, have not come forward to claim those vacancies. It can be ascertained only when some other vacancies are there on non joining by the selected candidates and the petitioners are next to them in the merit list.

No ground is made out to interfere at this stage.

The petition is dismissed as pre-mature.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
