Though, by virtue of instant petition, petitioners have sought a writ
in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant them ACP Scales

on completion of service of 8/16/24 years of service and also to release the 33% arrears of their revised salary in terms of recommendations made by fourth pay commission. Yet, a perusal of written statement of respondents No.2 and 3 clearly depicts and it is an admitted fact that benefit(s) of ACP Scale(s) have already been granted to the petitioners. As such, relief claimed by the petitioners in this regard has rendered infructuous.

3. As far as the release of 33% arrears of revised salary in terms of recommendations made by fourth pay commission is concerned, respondents No.2 and 3 has undertaken to release the said benefit(s) within a period of two months from today. Meaning thereby, that respondents No.2 and 3 admit their liability to pay the said benefit(s).

4. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to release the afore-said benefit(s) of revised salary within a period of two months from today. If the petitioners still feels dissatisfied, they may approach this Court.
