By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for granting the benefits 1st ACP and 2nd ACP along with consequential benefits to the petitioners and revised pension after considering the seniority w.e.f. 01.06.1993 and notional pay benefits, in the interest of justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a legal notice dated 25.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) was served upon the respondents but till date no decision is stated to have been taken by the concerned authorities.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 25.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) and to take a conscious decision that too by passing a speaking order and after hearing the petitioners, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
