TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner, who was serving as Senior Assistant (Accounts) under the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited (PUNSUP) has filed the instant petition impugning the order dated 20.06.2017 (Annexure P-12), whereby his services have been terminated.

Learned counsel at the very outset states that after filing of the petition, a subsequent order dated 04.08.2017 has been passed and in terms of which the termination order dated 20.06.2017 (Annexure P-12) has been withdrawn. Counsel further submits that on the same date i.e. on 04.08.2017, a notice has been served upon the petitioner calling upon him to show cause as to why his services should not be terminated.

Under such circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Suffice it to observe that it would always be open for the petitioner to approach this Court afresh to raise a challenge to any order

passed subsequently in point of time on the grounds available in accordance with law.
